First circular

General information

This is the first circular to announce the **Carpathian Summer School of Physics 2025**, that is scheduled to take place again in Sinaia, from June 22nd (arrival and registration) and July 3rd (departure), 2025. This will be the 31st edition of a tradition that begun in 1964.

It will have a wide distribution, including being posted on several professional sites that advertise scientific events.

The title is, as above:

"Exotic Nuclei and Nuclear/Particle Astrophysics (X). Physics with small accelerators"

and is the 10th in the latest series with the same title organized first in Mamaia (2005) and later in Sinaia (2007, 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016, 2018, 2021 and 2023). CSSP25 is part of the ENNAS (European Network of Nuclear Astrophysics Schools), a network recognized by the Division of Nuclear Physics of EPS and supported by the European projects ChETEC-INFRA and EURO-LABS.

The same format from recent events will be maintained: a combination of school-like and conference presentations, with 1-2 hour-long invited lectures by senior scientists/professors and several 20 minutes short student communications. It is aimed at graduate students, post-docs and young or established researchers. Students from all countries are invited to attend. A limited number of stipends to cover the local expenses for students will be available.

Venue, attractions

The conference will be held in **Sinaia**, a year-round mountain resort in the heart of the Carpathians, about 130 km north of Bucharest, about 1.5 hours' drive from the main international airport of Bucharest (OTP). The deadlines for registration are:

- for participants from countries that need visa for Romania (see http://www.mae.ro): April 15th, 2025;
- for participants from countries that do not need visa: **June 6th**, 2025.

Stipends.

As a rule, the participants should be supported by their home institution. However, a limited number of fellowships will be available for students (consisting of full or partial local support, but no transportation). The applicants should provide a short (one page) CV and a letter of recommendation from a professor or senior scientist who supports their application. Applications for fellowships can be made online with letters of support e-mailed to either of the directors. The deadline is **April 1**st, **2025**.

Abstracts/papers. The abstracts submitted will be made available on the school's web site. For that, participants who will give lectures and oral contributions are being asked to send the abstracts of their papers (less than 300 words) via email to cssp25@nipne.ro, before June 6th, 2025.
